The menu of services offered through the Hope & Healing Center have a common focus- rekindling hope and facilitating healing following a significant loss. Services include individual and family grief counseling, grief support groups, school-based grief counseling, remembrance events and specialized workshops. One of the popular grief support programs is Camp New Dawn, an annual summer camp for children, teens and families, who learn how to express their feelings after the loss of a loved one.

“Fundraising is essential for our grief support services offered through the Hope & Healing Center because many of them are offered free of charge.
